Fundraising is ***not mandatory*** this year.

It is available for those who want to reduce their program fee, at the rate of \$1 for every \$2 raised. Ask at registration for more information.

One of the **most important** things we teach is **good sportsmanship**. Sportsmanship is required of all – coaches, players, parents, and spectators. **Respect and fairness** are necessary for skillbuilding and teambuilding.



For practice and play, participants are separated in to **Divisions** by age as of July 1. Within each division, teams are assigned by age, size, and ability. Each **team will represent a range of abilities** and an important goal is that **all team members get equal play time**. That helps build skills, teamwork and respect.

Soccer practices and games will be on **Tuesdays and Thursdays** from 6-8 pm beginning **July 8th** and ending **August 14th**. We use Midlakes Schools Soccer Fields. The season is set up for everyone to play 12 games.



Game times, locations, and team assignments will be determined after registration closes. The coach of your team will contact you after the teams and schedules have been determined. You will get a **roster and schedule** for your team **from your coach**.
