

## YMCA OF THE USA NATIONAL COMMITTEE ON MEMBERSHIP STANDARDS

## The ten membership qualifications for every corporate association are as follows:

- 1. Acceptance of statement of purpose of the Young Men's Christian Associations of the United States of America
- 2. Governing documents designate the organization as a Young Men's Christian Association
- 3. Acceptance of the National Council Constitution
- 4. Monthly payment of financial support
- 5. Filing of the Annual Report
- 6. Chief Employed Officer meets the educational and training qualifications of that position as determined by the National Board
- 7. Non-discriminatory policies and practices in all areas (membership, board of directors, employees, and program participation)
- 8. IRS-recognized 501(c) (3) organization
- 9. Acknowledgement that the YMCA name, marks, logos, symbols and other intellectual property are the property of the National Council and may only be used as authorized by the National Board
- 10. Commitment not to act in a manner which adversely impacts the reputation of other member associations, the YMCA brand, or the national movement
