- 1. Determine mission and purpose
- 2. Select the chief executive
- 3. Support and evaluate the chief executive
- 4. Ensure effective planning
- 5. Monitor and strengthen programs and services
- 6. Ensure adequate financial resources
- 7. Protect assets and provide proper financial oversight
- 8. Build a competent board
- 9. Ensure legal and ethical integrity
- 10. Enhance the organization's public standing
